December 31, 2019

1. GENERAL

a) **Income Taxes**

This organization is a registered charity under Paragraph 149(1)(f) of the Income Tax Act and is, therefore, not subject to income taxes.

b) **Purpose and Intended Service**

The purpose of the organization is to raise funds for the Mennonite Central Committee of Canada World Relief and Development through the sale of goods made by volunteers in the community.
